Chippenham and District League

For many years TWTC has been entering teams in the Chippenham & District League; it's a great social league with some pretty serious tennis in the top teams, so why not join up and get that competitive spirit going.

- The league runs from early April until the beginning of August (depending on how often matches get rained off). Have a look here for more information - www.chdtl.co.uk
- To be eligible to play for one of TWTC's teams, you have to be a fully paid up junior/senior or full adult member of the tennis section.
- Our teams are selected on ability except for the last team in each competition (ladies' doubles, men's doubles & mixed doubles) which is open to anyone who wants to play on a rotational basis which is controlled by that team's captain.
- Committee have drawn up guidelines for our captain of captains and for our team captains detailing their responsibilities.
- If you would like to volunteer to be a team captain, we'd love to hear from you. Team captains will be confirmed at our AGM in January.
- Teams consist of two doubles pairings who play two matches, one against each of their opponent's two pairings starting at around 6pm and finishing with a meal of some kind depending on whether you are playing home or away.
- Match fees (£2 per match) are collected by the team captain who also arranges who will bring what food for home matches.
- It helps us to decide how many teams to enter in the leagues if we find out early from you if you want to play and an idea of how regularly.
- Matches are played as follows: Mixed A, B, C & D teams – Monday nights, Ladies' A&B teams – Wed nights, Men's A&B teams – Wed nights, Ladies' C & Men's C&D teams – Thursday nights
